

Provider Unit Obligation to Notify Policy

DNA approved Provider Units must notify the Delaware Nurses Association in writing within 7 days regarding any changes to the Approved Provider organization, including but not limited to:

- significant changes or events that impair the organization from meeting or continue to meet DNA/ANCC-COA requirements
- change in status that make the Provider Unit ineligible as an Approved Provider

Notification must be received in writing by DNA with 30 days for the following:

- changes that alter the information provided in the application including address or name change
- change in Primary Nurse Planner or suspension, lapse, revocation or termination of the Primary Nurse Planner's RN license
- change in Nurse Planners or suspension, lapse, revocation or termination of the Primary Nurse Planner's RN license
- change in ownership
